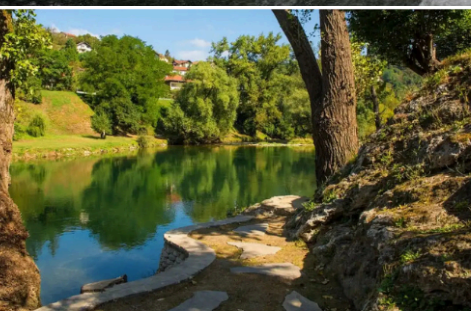

## Venue

The competition will take place on the spectacular Vrbas River canyon, just minutes from the city center of Banja Luka. This stretch of the river is widely regarded as one of the finest rafting venues in Southeast Europe, combining technical rapids with breathtaking scenery. The course offers a perfect balance between challenge and accessibility, making it ideal for high-level European Championship racing while remaining visually engaging for spectators.

Natural rock formations, clear waters, and steep canyon walls create a dramatic setting, while multiple viewing points along the river allow fans to follow the action closely. The proximity to the city ensures easy logistics for teams, officials, and visitors alike, with accommodation, services, and event facilities all within a short distance.

## How to get to Banja Luka

Reaching Banja Luka is straightforward, with several convenient travel options available. The nearest airport is Banja Luka International Airport (BNX), located about 25 km from the city center, offering regular connections to key European hubs. Alternatively, travelers can fly into Zagreb Airport (approximately 180 km away) or Sarajevo Airport (around 230 km), both providing a wider range of international flights.

Banja Luka is also well connected by road, with modern highways linking it to major regional cities. Direct bus services operate frequently from Zagreb, Sarajevo, and other Balkan destinations. For those traveling by car, the journey offers scenic views of rivers, mountains, and countryside landscapes. Once in the city, local transport and short travel distances make it easy to access the competition venue and accommodation areas.

## General information

The competition will be held in the **Classic Format**, including the disciplines: Sprint, RX and Slalom. The event will be organized in the following recognized divisions: **Men, Women, Mixed, Para-Rafting**

Age category: **Senior**

The race courses have a difficulty level of **III / III+**.

The event will be organised in accordance with the **United Rafting Sport Rules**.

## Registration

Entry and accreditation requests must be made by the National Federation using the [TheFlow](#). For detailed instructions on how to submit entries, please read [Registration handbook - National Delegations](#).

Any questions or issues to entries or accreditation should be sent to prior to the respective deadline.

Nominal entries deadline: **12th May 2026, 11:59 p.m CET**

The limit for teams' number for each National Federation is:

- 2 Senior Men Teams
- 2 Senior Women Teams
- 2 Senior Mixed Teams
- 2 Senior Para-Rafting Teams

**Event fee: €120 per person**

## **Reminder**

Each athlete competing must be entered by full name. Head of Delegations and staff must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.

Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or the competition organizer will NOT be accepted.

Accreditations do not include food, accommodation and transport

## **Terms of Payment**

Participation fees must be paid via TheFlow at the same time as registration.

Registration cannot be completed without payment. Any questions or issues related to entries or accreditation should be sent to the organizers prior to the respective deadline.

## Rafts

The official competition raft is the “Aquadesign Race Competition Raft”. Each team must use its own raft.

Exceptionally, teams that do not own this model may use a raft provided by the Organizing Committee, subject to a prior request sent by email to [raftingclubkanjon@gmail.com](mailto:raftingclubkanjon@gmail.com). **Teams and National Federations already in possession of this raft model are not permitted to use the rental service provided by the Organizing Committee.**

Teams requiring rafts are requested to inform the LOC in advance by email, specifying the number of rafts needed during the event. This communication is intended solely to assess the overall demand for the service and does not constitute a booking system for specific time slots.

The **rental fee** for use during official training sessions and competition is **€100 per team**.

Rafts will be issued upon payment of a security **deposit** of:

- **€300 per team, or**
- **€900 per nation delegation.**

The deposit may be paid in cash during accreditation.

Rafts must be collected shortly before each run and returned immediately afterwards, as they are required for use by other teams. The only exceptions are the RX semi-finals and finals.

Any nation retaining a raft for a subsequent run without authorization will be charged €100, which will be deducted from the deposit.

In the event of damage, repair costs will be deducted from the deposit. If the raft is deemed irreparably damaged and cannot be restored to a usable condition, the concerned National Federation will be required to reimburse the full replacement value of the raft, amounting to €950.

Any additional raft allocation will require an additional deposit.

Teams requiring rafts must proceed to Accreditation to pay the rental fee and deposit (only once). For each official training session or competition run, teams must report to the raft distribution area approximately 15 minutes before their scheduled start time to collect the raft.

## Sport venue areas

All competitors and officials will receive **accreditation** passes allowing access to the designated areas. General security at the venue will be guaranteed by a local security agency. The Organising Committee does not assume responsibility for missing equipment or other personal belongings.

**Parking areas** will be organised at the venue, and each team will be allowed to park one van with a trailer.

Rescue services will be present in the competition area **during the official training and competition time** to ensure water safety.

The Organising Committee kindly asks all participants to ensure that they have valid medical insurance in their respective countries. The Organising Committee will not cover any expenses related to hospital or dental treatment.

## Accommodation

The organiser will provide a free camp in Krupa on Vrbas. Teams wishing to use the camp must register by mail [raftingcentarkanjon@gmail.com](mailto:raftingcentarkanjon@gmail.com) (deadline May 03, 2026). The number of camping spots is limited. Places are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Note: National Delegations are responsible for their own accommodation if the camp is full. A list of nearby hotels can be provided upon request.
